The Board recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of involving members of the public in its meetings. The chair may interrupt or terminate an individual's statement when statements are out of order, too lengthy, personally directed, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant. The entire board shall have the final decision in determining the appropriateness of all such rulings. Members of the public shall be recognized and allowed input during the meeting, at the discretion of the chair. It is important for all participants to remember that board meetings are held in public but are not public meetings. If the Board understands the language of a public comment, translation is not automatic, and the Board will proceed forward with meeting business. Upon request, the Board will provide translation of public comment or business discussion conducted by the Board. Social conversation not in relation to decision-making at meetings will not be translated.
